This has been a year of great struggle: from Tahrir Square in Cairo; to the State Capitol in Madison; to Wall Street in New York; and LaSalle Street in Chicago.

The People's Thanksgiving is held every year to honor some of the leaders and rank and file fighters in the struggle today, especially those that have scored victories and made significant advances.

This year there's much to celebrate, but there's also attacks coming down on all those who struggle. The US and NATO continue their wars, and prepare for new ones; the G8 and the other agencies of the rulers of the wealthiest nations, like Wall Street and their politicians here, are demanding that workers everywhere and the oppressed nations accept greater misery.

The resistance against attacks on workers and oppressed nations has surged in response to the intensified attacks. The Arab Spring saw uprisings in Tunisia and Egypt against US backed dictatorships, and solidarity with the Palestinians in their resistance to occupation has increased as well around the US and the world. The protest movements in the Middle East have spread across the globe to the US, including Chicago; and the resistance to US/NATO wars and the G8 poverty agenda is going to see 10s of thousands marching in Chicago in May against their summit.
